Chairman's introduction



This is my first year as Chair and I'm very pleased to introduce Edinburgh Photographic Society's 161st International Exhibition. My thanks to everyone who entered, thank you for taking the time to do so and for sharing your work with us all.

As you will see from this catalogue, and hopefully in person, we have a varied selection of image genres and styles. As you look at the images you should admire the skill required to create these prints. Not only are the images beautiful, but, the skill required to create the prints take them to higher level. They really are best seen in person.

Many thanks to our experienced and valued judges : Armando Jongejan FRPS BMK (Netherlands), Margaret Salisbury FRPS Hon.FDPS FIPF FSITTP FSINWP MFIAP ZGPU AWPf APAGB (Wales) and Colin Westgate MFIAP MPAGB APAG (England). They all have a wealth of experience in creating images and judging and used all of that experience to select the best images for our exhibition.

This year we had 1412 entries from 210 photographers from 20 countries. Sadly this is a reduction in both the number of countries and entrants compared to last year. The spiralling world-wide postal costs continue to provide a barrier to entry, particularly for entrants outside of the UK. However, we received entries from all around the world and look forward to continuing to do so.

Edinburgh is one of the few print exhibitions that displays all of the accepted images and we only accept what we can display. Gaining an acceptance is difficult and our acceptance rate has often been less than 10%. This year we accepted 163 prints which means our overall acceptance rate is just over 11%.

This means that photographers who achieve an acceptance should be very proud. For those of you who were not accepted this year I know you are disappointed, but, let me encourage you to keep trying. Let this spur you to further efforts and we will welcome your entry next year.

The exhibition is available to visit at 68 Great King Street, Edinburgh, EH3 6QU, Scotland throughout August 2025 as we are part of the Edinburgh Festivals.

I look forward to welcoming some of the authors, fellow photographers and the many visitors who come to appreciate and admire the range and quality of these prints. Some come because they have received an acceptance and want to see their print on display and some come simply to admire the work. We have many visitors who return every year and if you are not already a regular I hope that you become one. It is a wonderful exhibition and every year is different and well worth seeing.

My thanks go to the Edinburgh Photographic Society International Committee for their support and also to the members of the society who volunteered to help throughout the whole process; a true team effort.

Finally, I'd like to invite you all to enter our future competitions. We run two competitions each year, one for prints and one for digital images. They are both open to all photographers. The 4th EPS International Digital Salon 2025 opens for entry in August 2025 and the 162nd Edinburgh International Photography Exhibition 2026 will open for print entries in March/April 2026. Colin Westgate MFIAP MPAGB APAGB (England)

My photographic journey started way back in 1959, when I was given a very basic 35mm camera for my 21st birthday. I was immediately 'hooked' and soon bought an enlarger and started to make prints wherever I could find a space to 'black out' in the house. My initial interest was, and has remained so, in photographing the landscape, but I have always appreciated and enjoyed other genres. I have always enjoyed making prints, as I consider that to be the culmination of my photographic endeavours.

Photography has, therefore, been a fulfilling lifetime passion for me, and to have been invited to be one of the selectors for the 2025 Edinburgh International Print Exhibition was a very special privilege and a fitting conclusion to my 50+ years of judging.



Armando Jongejan FRPS BMK (Bonds Meester Klasse) (The Netherlands)

Armando studied photography at the University of Applied Photography in Apeldoorn and works as a freelance photographer. His work is characterised by a thematic approach. As a documentary photographer, he likes to make contact with people in their own environment being curious as to how they live and work. In addition to the photos, this also yields nice conversations.

Since 1990 Armando Jongejan has regularly exhibited. His work has been published in various (photo)magazines. He has also published many books and the most recent is Thailand with a smile (2025). In addition, Armando's work is included in the collections of the Regional Archive Alkmaar, the Photography Museum of Lishui (China) and in private and corporate collections.

Armando became in 2018 a lecturer for PermaJet and is giving lectures, workshops, mentoring, presentations, judging in the Netherlands, Belgium, England, Scotland and Ireland.

Armando is a member of two national groups of the Dutch Royal Photo Association: Documentary and the BMK. In 2009 he was accepted as fellow by the Royal Photographic Society (FRPS) and he became in 2020 Hon life Member (Fenton Medal) of the RPS and is a member of the Conceptual and Contemporary Panel for Associate & Fellowship.

Her first love is "Pictorial Photography" whether it be the Slate Landscapes of North Wales, Environmental Portraiture in Africa, Street Photography, Creative, Nature, Landscape, etc. Print or PDIs in Monochrome or Colour. A committed Print Worker she has been an Ambassador for Fotospeed for many years. She enjoys, Lecturing, in person or on Zoom also Judging and Selecting as it enables her to see many wonderful images.

Her favourite area of photography, as well as taking and making images is "Mentoring" she believes that going for "Distinctions or Awards" gives Photographers a challenge and a sense of achievement. Margaret has served on many different Distinctions Panels, is currently the Chairman of the DPS L, A, and F, Distinctions Panel. Over a period of 40 years Margaret has helped just over 2,000 photographers achieve their aim.

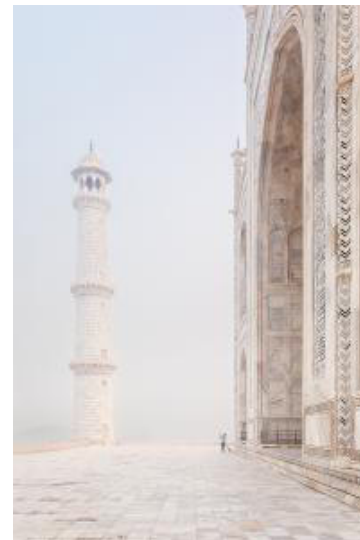

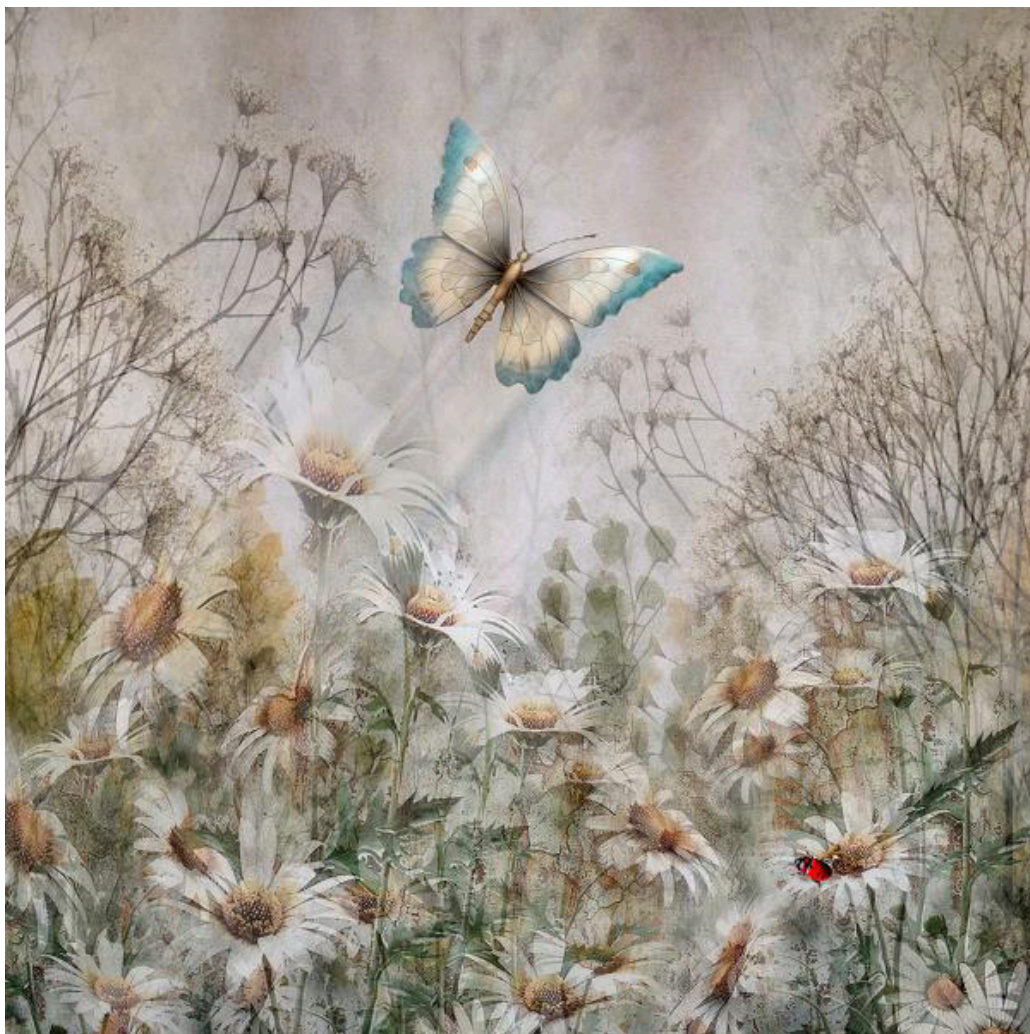

So many I feel could have been awarded a Gold Medal.

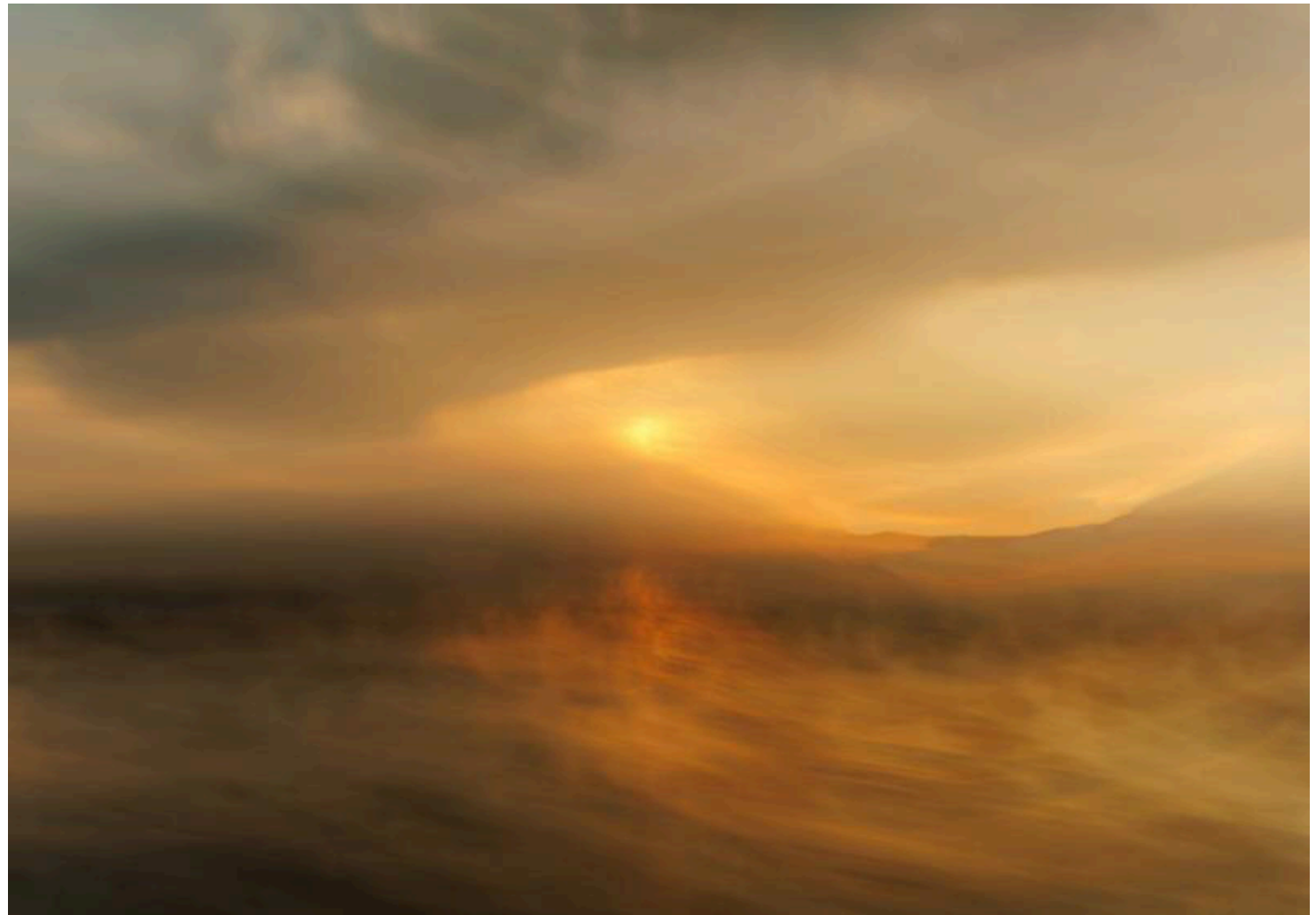

The camera is capable of recording the finest detail, but as a result, the literal reality of a subject, such as a landscape, may not always adequately express what the photographer feels at the moment the shutter is released.

'Impressionist Sunset' is a fine example of where the photographer has used his technique to soften the detail of a scene to the extent that shapes, colour and tone are all that remain.
